The CIM Foundation



In 2015, the CIM Foundation experienced a period of change and new developments. In May, three new members of the Board joined the CIM Foundation; Adam Tonnos, who had also served on the Board of CIM, Dean Journeaux, a longstanding donor and member of the Montreal Branch of CIM, as well as Louise Michaud who is also a member of the Calgary Branch of CIM. Daniel Gagnon, member of the Board of the CIM Foundation since 2011, and who had also served on the Board of CIM, was voted in as new President by his fellow Trustees. These changes heralded a renewal at the Foundation level with closer ties to CIM and its members.

The CIM Foundation Manager continued to visit Branches and Societies and provided them with educational material created by the Foundation in partnership with the Club de Minéralogie. This partnership has been flourishing since 2011, when Roger Guay Ph.D., then Vice President of the Club, offered to help the CIM Foundation develop mineral cards and accompanying educational material. These tools were developed to provide youth and their educators with a better understanding and appreciation of minerals and what mining contributes to our daily lives. Dr. Guay had already been working as an advisor with M4S and was a member of the CIM Montreal Branch. Over the years, he contributed to the creation of over 400 mineral cards, a growing number of mineral-match panels (the ATV, Cell phone, Bicycle, 797F Caterpillar Truck, Caterpillar shovel and the Satellite panels) as well as a mineral Bingo game. Dr. Guay also travelled with the Foundation to Kuujuaq in April 2014 as well as 2015 to present educational workshops to students at the elementary and secondary levels of the Jaanimmarik school.

In September, the Foundation travelled to Chibougamau to present workshops at a special weekend organized by Development Chibougamau.

In 2015 CIMF participated in the following events: Franco-mine (Toronto, Ontario), M4S (Kuujuaq, Nunavik), CIM Conference (Montreal, Québec), Richesses naturelles en découverte (Chibougamau, Québec).

In 2015 CIMF:

- Distributed 2,000 decks of cards to students and the general public.
- Distributed over 23,000 mineral cards to students and the general public at events.
- Distributed 600 mineral posters to teachers for classroom use.
- Provided select aboriginal students with access to information about minerals (cards) in their own languages.
- Provided over 8,500 students with information about minerals and their importance during educational events, including M4S.
- Provided 220 CIM Conference delegates with items from CIM Foundation auctions in Montreal.

- Provided over 10,000 CIM members with the CIM Foundation newsletter (fall) and annual report (spring) included in their copies of CIM Magazine.



The Foundation is continuing to forge closer relationships with CIM Branches and Societies by providing them with scholarship information and educational material. The CIM Manager provided CIM Branch members, including officials from the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador, with the electronic files for the ATV and the Bicycle panels as well as the corresponding files with their accompanying mineral cards. These panels and their accompanying cards will be printed in Newfoundland and used during educational presentations by Newfoundland government officials. These mineral-match panels will then be distributed to schools who wish to continue to use them.

Scholarships

Last year, \$85,000 in scholarships was awarded to 22 deserving students in more than 11 universities, colleges and CEGEPs across Canada.
